

Availability of counseling services for foreign nationals

♦Local governments' handling of multilingual counseling




■ Availability of multilingual information



■Requisites for promoting programs pertinent to foreign women

Many centers cited the need for "Liaison and information exchange among related individuals and institutions" (81.9%) and "Assessment of the current situation surrounding foreign women" (71.4%) to facilitate taking measures to assist foreign women.

Gender Equality and Globalization: Foreign women living in Japan

The Fourth Basic Plan for Gender Equality and initiatives targeting foreign women and international cooperation

The Fourth Basic Plan for Gender Equality was approved by the Cabinet in December 2015. As with previous plans, it addresses the need to demonstrate appropriate consideration and establish a favorable environment for foreign women, as well as international cooperation and contributions.

Priority Field 7

Elimination of all forms of violence against women

- Creation of a foundation for eliminating and preventing violence against
- Furtherance of the prevention of spousal violence and the protection and
- Commitment to ensuring everyone dealing with victims in the line of duty demonstrates appropriate consideration
- Promotion of effective measures to address trafficking in persons

Priority Field 8

Creation of an environment in which women and others facing hardship as a result of poverty, old age, disabilities or other similar challenges can live comfortably

It is important to consider circumstances in which foreign nationals living in Japan experience additional hardship because they are women from the standpoint of respect for human rights.


Accordingly, gender-equal perspectives must be integrated when nurturing an environment in which people facing a variety of hardships can live with peace of mind.


Increases in the number of women immigrating

Women account for a high proportion of both Japanese nationals living overseas and foreign nationals living in Japan



■Number of foreign national residents by visa type




■Percentage of foreign women in Japan by region and by country



■Trends in the number of Japanese nationals living overseas and countries of abode

The number of Japanese nationals living overseas accounted for by women has exceeded that of men since 1999. Of them, women account for more permanent residents, but men account for more long-term residents.

A questionnaire on the following categories of programs offered by centers as measures pertinent to foreign women was conducted.


■ Availability of programs

146 centers responded "No programs pertinent to foreign women." The most frequently adopted measure was "Programs for regular citizens to facilitate international understanding/exchange" (30 centers), followed by "Counseling and other direct support for foreign women" (17 centers).
